House White

Cave de Masse Colombard-Ugni Blanc Dry White, Vin de France (France) £13.90

Crisp, dry, lemony aromas and apple freshness. 250ml £4.95

White Wines

1. Condesa de Iganza Virua, La Mancha (Spain) £14.90

Top quality Viura fruit produces this light, crisp, fresh, citrusy and apple flavoured wine.

2. Chablis Domaine Gilbert Picq et Fils (France) £28.90

This is a dry, ripe Chardonnay of great style, with the gunflint characteristic for which the region is famous.

3. Macon-Villages Domaine de la Grange Magnien, Louis Jadot (France) £17.90

Excellent softer style of burgundy, fresh, full flavoured with pleasant citrus and buttery undertones.

4. Prini Pinot Grigio delle Venezie (Italy) £14.90

Distinctive nose of wild flowers, with touches of honey and banana; soft, fresh and lively with notes of ripe pear.

5. Tierra Sauvignon Blance, Central Valley (Chile) £23.90

Pale yellow with fresh fruit, citrus and mineral notes and a clean finish.

6. Sancerre, La Fuzelle, Adrien Marechal (France) £28.90

Distinctively elegant. Laden with racy crispness and abundant gooseberry crunch.

7. Hardys The Riddle Chardonnay-Semillon (South-Eastern Australia) £14.90

A popular blend, combining a soft creamy texture with lime flavours and subtle oak characters that deliver a crisp dry white wine.

8. Gewurztraminer Alsace, Portrait Range Domaine Zinck (France) £19.90

Off-dry, with a balancing fresh fruit character of pear, rose petal and lychee: enhanced with exotic notes of spice and a pinch of peppermint.

Rosé Wines

Mateus Rose, Sogrape Vinhos de Portugal (Portugal) £13.20

Soft, strawberry fruit on the nose and a gentle taste, with a slight sparkle. Easy to understand why this is so popular.

Vita Zinfandel Rose, Puglia (Italy) £14.90

From the deep south of Italy, subtle strawberry fruit, finishes with a touch of sweetness.

House Red

Cave de Masse Merlot-Carignan Red, Vin de France (France) £13.90

Deliciously soft, ripe, red fruit flavours with a smooth finish. 250ml £4.95

Red Wines

1. Fleurie Les Muriennes, Thorin (France) £24.90

The name fleurie aptly describes the fresh, floral style of the wine.

2. Chianti, Ruffino (Italy) £15.90

Harmonious and mellow, with violet and red berry notes on a soft and refreshing finish.

3. Luis Felipe Edwards Lot 40 Cabernat Sauvignon, Rapel Valley (Chile) £14.90

Deep red with ripe berry-fruit and wispy green pepper. Medium bodied, ripe tannins and lingering fruit on the finish.

4. Kleine Zalze Pinotage, Stellenbosch (South Africa) £15.90

A deep-coloured wine made from South Africa's 'own' grape variety. Excellent berry fruit flavours and soft tannins from vineyards located in the beautiful region of Stellenbosch.

5. Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir, Vin de France (France) £17.90

From the foothill of the Pyrenees, soft, lightly oaked cherries and blueberries with a hint of spice.

6. Vina Pomal Centenario Rioja Crianza (Spain) £17.90

Black fruit, liquorice and subtle mineral notes, cocoa and toasty notes from barrel ageing: supple and balanced.

7. Portillo Malbec, Valle de Uco, Mendoza (Argentina) £15.90

Plums, blackberries and a touch of vanilla: fresh fruit flavours, supported by a touch of spice.

8. The Gourmet Shiraz, South Australia (Australia) £17.90

Restrained blackberry fruit backed by a crisp finish.

Champagne & Sparkling

Sant' Orsola Prosecco Extra Dry (Italy) £19.95
Light and lively, with ripe pears and lemons rounded off with a hint of sweetness.

Moet & Chandon Brut Imperial (France) £55.90

A well known blend of older reserves with young wines to ensure a consistency of this flowery aroma and warm biscuit hints.
